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Students Accountabilities:

- ❖ Students ought to adhere to all rules and behaviour expectations.
- ❖ Before entering the lab, students are required to complete the pre-skill assignments.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of students to make sure that items are replaced and stored correctly.
- ❖ Students should always put safety first.
- ❖ In the laboratory setting, students ought to exhibit professionalism and courteousness towards their peers.
- ❖ Under the guidance of instructors or staff, students are encouraged to use the available equipment for learning and skill practice.
- ❖ Before using any equipment outside of scheduled lab sessions, they should obtain prior permission.
- ❖ If any equipment that is checked out to students is lost, broken, or not returned, they are financially accountable for it.

OVERALL GUIDELINES:

- ❖ For safety and hygienic concerns, students should follow the prescribed dress code, which may include taking off their slippers outside the lab and tying up long hair.
- ❖ Food items are prohibited from entering the lab.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the students to replenish any supplies they utilize in the lab in the appropriate areas.
- ❖ Before entering the lab, students must obtain permission from the lab incharge.
- ❖ Isolated student stays in the lab are not permitted.


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- ❖ To maintain cleanliness and avoid risks, it is important to follow proper disposal procedures for spent supplies, materials, liquids, and rubbish.
- ❖ If any equipment is broken, missing, or needs to be replaced, students should tell the skill lab coordinator right away.
- ❖ When the lab is not in use, the doors must be locked.
