INTRODUCTION

- Mid -level health providers (MLPs) are health workers trained at a higher education institution for at least 2-3 years. They are authorized to work autonomously to diagnose, manage and treat illness, disease and impairments, as well as engage in preventive and promotive care.

DEFINITION

- According to the World Health Organisation (WHO), a mid-level health provider (MLHP) or mid-level health worker (MLHW) is referred to as a health provider who has completed pre-service higher education (at least 2-3 years) and who is trained, authorised and regulated to work autonomously, and whose scope of practice
